### PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

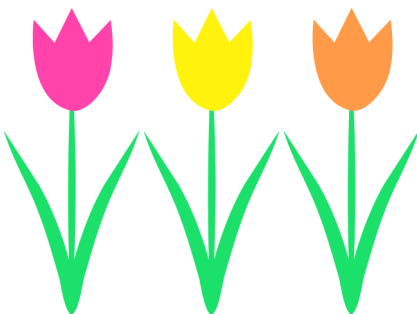
